### Standard Black Chef Coat

- Clean, fitted, and in good condition.
- Must be free from logos or company names.
- Can be short or long sleeved.

### Solid Plain Black Pants

- No stripes or patterns.
- No jeans, leggings or sweat pants.
- Proper fit

### Black Pillbox Hat

- Wear a chef hat at all times while working in the kitchen.
- Color should be all black.

### Black Apron

- Must be all black, with no stains and always clean.
